

ANNUAL IFPDA BOOK AWARD GUIDELINES

The International Fine Print Dealers Association seeks to encourage research, scholarship, and the discussion of new ideas in the field of fine prints by annually awarding the author(s) of one outstanding publication a prize of \$2,000 and a framed award. The competition is open to works published during the previous year discussing any aspect of printmaking from its beginnings to the present day. The winner(s) of the award is announced each year in November during the Annual IFPDA Print Fair.

Guidelines

- Works submitted for consideration must be received no later than June 1st of the current year
- To be eligible, a work must have been published during the previous year. Unpublished works are not eligible for consideration
- Books, exhibition catalogues, or articles are all eligible for consideration
- The jury reserves the right not to make an award if the submissions received fail to meet the IFPDA Award Standards and Guidelines
- The decision of the jury is final

Review Criteria

Review of submissions will be made by a jury composed of experts in the field of study that is most appropriate to the submission. The jury will evaluate each submission on the basis of its presentation of fresh ideas, contribution of original research and creative interpretation of prior scholarship.

Submission Requirements

- To nominate a publication, please submit two copies of the work accompanied by an IFPDA Book Award Submission Sheet
- Application materials will not be returned
- Applicants will receive confirmation by email that their submission has been received
